Aim and Scope

The M.A. Program in Military Education Management aims to conduct scientific studies with other academic institutions at national and international levels in an interdisciplinary approach, including the social sciences such as psychology and sociology. In this context, the program aims to graduate students who may contribute to the scientific information accumulation by combining theory and practice and by studying military cadets and military lecturers from various levels of society in order to improve the military education.

The M.A. Program in Military Education Management in the Atatürk Institute of Strategic Studies (AISS) is the first graduate program on this subject in Turkey. The curriculum combines theory and practice on this field and offers an interdisciplinary approach including military psychology and sociology, historical development of military history, program development, evaluation techniques, architectural structure and planning of military education, organisational climate and culture, values education.

Career Opportunities

Our graduates may continue their professional careers in the educational units of the Turkish National Defence University, educational development units of Ministry of National Defence, supervisory units of Higher Education Institution or Ministry of National Education. They may work as academic, lecturer or administrator in the institutes, academies, vocational higher education schools subordinate to the Turkish National Defence University or as research assistant in other universities. They may also be employed as specialist or supervisor in various public institutions or the private sector.
